

WARRANTY

It is each individual dentist's responsibility to warranty his or her own work. Complete Dentistry is not responsible for the warranty of the individual dentist who provides treatment. No dentist has any obligation to rectify another dentist's work.

Dental Sealants – 1-year warranty

Our commitment to you

We will repair or replace dental sealants at no extra charge to you

What is covered?

- Breaking, chipping or wear of sealant

Composite resin (White) fillings – 2-year warranty

Our commitment to you

We will repair or replace fillings at no extra charge to you

What is covered?

- Breaking, chipping or wear of filling
- If the tooth breaks and requires a crown or inlay/onlay we will refund you the price of the filling and put is towards the crown or inlay/onlay

Composite resin (White) fillings (Primary / baby teeth) – 1-year warranty

Our commitment to you

We will repair or replace fillings at no extra charge to you

What is covered?

- Breaking, chipping or wear of filling
- If the tooth breaks and requires a crown or inlay/onlay we will refund you the price of the filling and put is towards the crown or inlay/onlay

Stainless steel crowns – 2-year warranty

Our commitment to you

We will replace at no extra charge to you

What is covered?

- Recementing crown

Crowns – 5-year warranty

Our commitment to you

We will replace or repair the crown at no extra cost to you. If you have a health fund, we will only charge the health fund. If we cannot replace or repair the crown, we may choose to refund your out of pocket expense for the treatment.

What is covered?

- Breaking, chipping or wear of crown
- Recementing crown

Bridges – 5-year warranty

Our commitment to you

We will replace or repair the bridge at no extra cost to you. If you have a health fund, we will only charge the health fund. If we cannot replace or repair the bridge, we may choose to refund your out of pocket expense for the treatment.

What is covered?

- Breaking, chipping or wear of crown
- Recementing crown

Inlay / Onlays – 5-year warranty

Our commitment to you

We will replace or repair the inlay/onlay at no extra cost to you. If you have a health fund, we will only charge the health fund. If we cannot replace or repair the inlay/onlay we may choose to refund your out of pocket expenses for the treatment.

What is covered?

- Breaking, chipping or wear of inlay / onlay
- Recementing inlay / onlay
- If the inlay / onlay is damaged so that a full crown is needed, we will refund you the price of the inlay / onlay and put it towards the crown

Porcelain Veneers – 5-year warranty

Our commitment to you

We will replace or repair the veneer at no extra cost to you. If you have a health fund, we will only charge the health fund. If we cannot replace or repair the veneer, we may choose to refund your out of pocket expense for the treatment.

What is covered?

- Breaking, chipping or wear of veneer
- Recementing veneer
- If the veneer is damaged so that a full crown is needed, we will refund you the price of the veneer and put it towards the crown

Root Canal Treatment – 5-year warranty

Our commitment to you

We will replace or repair the root canal at no extra cost to you. (Only applies to a full course of Root Canal Treatment carried out in a timely manner following the dentist's recommendation) If you have a health fund, we will only charge the health fund. If we cannot replace or repair the root canal, we may choose to refund your out of pocket expense for the treatment. Root Canals are only guaranteed if they have a full crown placed to reinforce them, unless explicitly advised by the dentist as not requiring a crown

What is covered?

- Failure of root canal
- Persisting infection or pain

WHAT IS NOT COVERED?

For all the above dental treatment what is NOT covered under warranty

- **Biological or behavioral failures**

Your responsibility (failure to comply will void warranty)

Attend you recommended active maintenance appointments (Minimum every 6 months unless otherwise stated) and have any recommended exams and x-rays completed. Follow recommended instructions for maintaining good oral health
